Jesus was a man anointed to heal.

The Spirit of God is moving and manifesting in the local church today.

The Spirit of God has moved throughout history.

1850's Charles Finney – move of God-

Whole City of Boston was affected.

The city shut down for prayer every noon.

Early 1900's Azusa Street in California.

People who were hungry prayed and the Spirit moved.

Moves of God got stagnant because people get complacent  
But God's always moving.

1950's Great Healing Revival

For ten years it was easy to get healed by the Gifts.

People prayed and were hungry. This is characteristic of every move of God.

In the 50's people completely relied on the gifts of the Spirit.

(Kuhlman; Allen) People who weren't affected by the gifts were not taught about FAITH and went away sick.

Since - Teaching Revival - WORD WORD WORD FAITH FAITH FAITH

We're coming into a move of the Spirit of God.

We will see all the gifts of the Spirit in manifestation in these last days as well as people of faith.

All the moves of God will be wrapped up in this last move.

Gifts of the Spirit will manifest, but the Word of God will prevail.

Miracles, Signs, and Wonders will be seen.

The Power of God will flow through all of us.

Our faith will work mightily.

The results will be God's harvest of souls!!!

Holy Spirit will be using you!!

He came into you to flow out of you.

1 Cor 12:1

2:1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant.  
KJV

E.W. Vine's Now about...  
"some of the appointed activities of the Holy Ghost.

1 Cor 12:4-11

4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.

6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

1 Cor 12:31-13:1

31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.

KJV

COVET = CRAVE (supernatural movings of the Holy Spirit)

1 Cor 2:4-5

4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

KJV

Not just with word, but Faith in the Power.

There will be great works of power here today

Spirit is already moving in here – He's on some of you now.

Let's talk about **JESUS** and the **BIG PICTURE**.

Gen 3:14-15

14And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:

15And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

KJV

God responds to sin.

God sentences Satan's life.

Refers to Christ as SEED.

Gal 3:15

15Brethren, I speak after the manner of men; Though it be but a man's covenant, yet if it be confirmed, no man disannulleth, or addeth thereto.

KJV

Christ = Anointed one and His Anointing (singular)

After the fall now (the curse of sickness and disease entered in)  
(the law of sin and death reigned.)

No person, born of a woman is a threat to the devil because of this law at work unless he is anointed.

Satan before his fall from heaven was called Lucifer = one of God's arch angels

He was called the anointed cherub.

He knows and understands the anointing.

Now the devil knows there is a man or seed coming who will have the anointing – His purpose will be to conquer Satan.

This is reason Prophets were killed (by evil men) because Satan didn't know which anointed man was the one!

Jesus was born and grew up and displayed no great power or miracles.

Mark 1:1

1:1The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;

KJV

Look what it says here THE BEGINNING

Mark 1:11

11And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

KJV

(River Jordan) no gifts / no miracles / no healings

John the Baptist 28 years of preparation

6 years of ministry (most do it the opposite)

Mark 1:13

13And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of Satan; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.

KJV

Verse 13 has new meaning – the Devil saw Him being anointed.

Acts 10:38

38How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

KJV

ANOINTED JESUS OF NAZERETH (MAN) NOT CHRIST OR SON OF GOD

Luke 4:1

4:1And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

KJV

“FULL OF” MEANS YOU HAD TO HAVE BEEN EMPTY

Main point I want you to see is:

**1) THERE IS A BEGINNING TO JESUS' MINISTRY AS AN ANOINTED MAN**

HE DID NOT DEFEAT SATAN AS SON OF GOD

HE DID NOT HEAL THE SICK AS SON OF GOD

HE DID NOT CAST OUT DEVILS AS SON OF GOD

HE DID NOT RAISE THE DEAD AS SON OF GOD

OR EVEN TEACH AS SON OF GOD

## BUT AS A MAN ANOINTED BY GOD

### Gate Beautiful

Peter tells people who they killed (Christ)

Acts 3:1-16

3:1 Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour.

2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;

3 Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.

4 And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.

5 And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them.

6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

9 And all the people saw him walking and praising God:

10 And they knew that it was he which sat for alms at the Beautiful gate of the temple: and they were filled with wonder and amazement at that which had happened unto him.

11 And as the lame man which was healed held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering.

12 And when Peter saw it, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?

13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.

14 But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

15 And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses.

16 And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

KJV

Jesus came to earth as Son of Man.

He did not walk the earth and do all he did as Son of God.

Man got us into trouble and a man needed to get us out of trouble.

Luke 3:21-23

21 Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened,

22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

**23 And Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age**, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, which was the son of Heli,

KJV

Jesus Himself, when He began (His Ministry) was about 30 years of age.

John 1:1

1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

KJV

The Beginning.

John 1:29-30

**29 The next day** John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

The Next Day.

30 This is he of whom I said, After me **cometh a man** which is preferred before me: for he was before me.

KJV

Comes as a man not GOD

John 2:1

2: **1 And the third day** there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:

KJV

On the THIRD DAY a wedding in Cana

John 2:11

11 This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

KJV

This is the beginning the first of His signs (miracles, wonderworks)

John 17:5

5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.

KJV

With Father in heaven

John 14:10

10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

KJV

Father does the work

This is how it flows to us.

Phil 2:7-11

7But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

8And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

9Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

10That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

11And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

KJV

Verse 7 Stripped Himself of all privileges. Laid aside His Glory..

Said all that to say this,

## **2) GOD CAN ANOINT OUR HUMANITY (ME & YOU) JUST LIKE HE DID JESUS**

(WHO WENT ABOUT DOING GOOD AND HEALING ALL WHO WERE OPPRESSED OF THE DEVIL. FOR GOD WAS **WITH** HIM.)

John 14:12

12Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

KJV

## **3) If you think the anointing and healing power was upon Jesus as the Son of God – you'll have difficulty receiving.**

Luke 4:16-20

16And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

17And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written,

18The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

19To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

20And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him.

KJV

All eyes gazed upon him.

Customs = something done on a regular basis  
Why – there was an (power) anointing that was tangible.

Verse 21 WHAM!!! “TODAY”

What was special about TODAY

Isa 10:27

27And it shall come to pass ***in that day***, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.

KJV

Jesus operated in all the gifts of the Spirit (except tongues and interpretation of tongues)

Jesus didn't get upset when there wasn't a manifestation of the Holy Spirit.

He'd just walk them to the outside of town.

He'd teach the Word.

John 5:1-19

5:1After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

2Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep market a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches.

3In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

4For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.

5And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.

6When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, Wilt thou be made whole?

7The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me.

8Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.

9And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.

10The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry thy bed.

11He answered them, He that made me whole, the same said unto me, Take up thy bed, and walk.

12Then asked they him, What man is that which said unto thee, Take up thy bed, and walk?

13And he that was healed wist not who it was: for Jesus had conveyed himself away, a multitude being in that place.

14Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.

15The man departed, and told the Jews that it was Jesus, which had made him whole.

16And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.

17But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.

18Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.

19Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

KJV

Best example of Jesus operating in the gifts of the Spirit.

He Knew

Word of Knowledge

Called Him Sir

He didn't know Jesus

Rise and walk (gift of Special Faith) usually to one person.

If it was Jesus' Faith - He'd heal everyone.

If no gift in manifestation and they were ignorant or didn't want to be healed

– only thing to do - teach the Word - Jesus did.

–

In temple sin no more lest a worse thing come unto you.

Disbelieve no more or else!

Mark 6:4-6

4But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house.

5And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them.

6And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

KJV

John 5:

Verse 17 Son can do nothing of myself (Same with us!)

Verse 19 only do what the Father does.

He didn't operate in His own power, but the power of God.

Went into these porches aware of surroundings

Are gifts manifesting?

For 20? For 10?

For 1?

If not, TEACH THE WORD.

People will receive healing by faith.

Mark 9:17-30

17And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit;

18And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not.

19He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him unto me.

20And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming.

21And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child.

22And oftentimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.

23Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

24And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.

25When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.

26And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead.

27But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.

28And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out?

29And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.

30And they departed thence, and passed through Galilee; and he would not that any man should know it.

KJV

IF YOU BELIEVE. THIS IS NOT A MANIFESTATION OF THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT.

The Gifts of the Spirit in the Epistles were without fanfare.

They were very practical.

They seem very natural, not spooky.

In the Book of Acts the Holy Spirit is mentioned 52 times and Prayer is mentioned 40 times.

Now the Holy Spirit is on the scene and He is moving.

Everything Jesus did was in Company.

Father, Son and Holy Ghost. They were always unified. The only thing Jesus ever did alone was die.

God = Originator=Coach

Jesus = Initiator = Quarterback

Holy Spirit = Manifestor = Receiver

God originates the plan (His ways, His thoughts)

Jesus initiates the Plan by the Word (either logos or Rhema, written or spoken)

Then, as we walk by faith

Holy Spirit manifests the Plan.

Mary (Mother) at Cana put a demand on The Word (Jesus).

She said, "WHATEVER HE SAYS, DO."

You must DO something to get a manifestation.

Gen 1:1 Spirit is hovering now also waiting to manifest The Word.

He's hovering over you right now to heal....
