

THE ROAD TO HEALING MANIFESTATIONS

Mark 5:25-27

25And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,

26And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,

27When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

KJV

This womans road was not taking her to a place of wholeness.

Something Happened that changed the road she was on.

She met Jesus! He offered her a new road.

This new road brought quick results – manifestations. – lasting changes!

Sometimes we get on the wrong road.

We need to be open to a new path.

Luke 7:1-3

7:1Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.

2And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick, and ready to die.

3And when he heard of Jesus, he sent unto him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal his servant.

KJV

Someone offered the centurion a new option for his dying servant. The new road was Jesus and it brought manifestations.

There is a road to fruit in Mark 4 that we can follow.

Turn to Mark 4:14

Mark 4:14-20

14The sower soweth the word.

15And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.

16And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;

17And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

18And these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word,

19And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

20And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.

There is a road that leads to health.
There is a reason why we should follow this path and strive for health.

John 15:8
8Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit;
KJV

He desires us to bear fruit and that's why He shows us how to get there.

THERE ARE THREE STEPS TO OBTAIN MANIFESTATIONS

The first one is found in Mark 4:15

1)KEEP SATAN FROM STEALING THE WORD OUT OF YOUR HEART BY UNDERSTANDING THE WORD.

Mark 4:15
15And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.
KJV

Matt 13:18-19
18Hear ye therefore the parable of the sower.
19When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth it not, then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side.
KJV

You can't bear fruit in an arena you don't understand.

Matt 13:15
15For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.
KJV

Eph 1:18
18The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,
KJV

FF Bosworth in his book, Christ The Healer, said, "Doubt and sin and disease can always be destroyed by the right use of the "eyes of our understanding.""

Fruit (or healings or manifestations) are always connected with understanding.

Matt 13:23

23But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.

KJV

#2 is found in Mark 4:16 & 17

Mark 4:16-17

16And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;

17And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

KJV

These people have heard and understood the word, but they abandon what they believe when trouble arises.

2) KEEP YOURSELF FROM ABANDONING WHAT WE UNDERSTAND WHEN DIFFICULTY ARISES.

If you give up on what you understand to be true, you'll never get a manifestation.

Let's look at a few examples:

John 12:42-43

42Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue:

43For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God.

KJV

It says, "Many believed"

They heard, accepted, believed, but when trouble came, they abandoned what they understood. They couldn't face getting kicked out of the club.

What will you do when the bad report comes from the Doctor?

Deut 1:22-27

22Then all of you came to me and said, "Let us send men ahead to spy out the land for us and bring back a report about the route we are to take and the towns we will come to."

23The idea seemed good to me; so I selected twelve of you, one man from each tribe. 24They left and went up into the hill country, and came to the Valley of Eshcol and explored it. 25Taking with them some of the fruit of the land, they brought it down to us and reported, "It is a good land that the LORD our God is giving us."

26But you were unwilling to go up; you rebelled against the command of the LORD your God.

NIV

All Israel was in faith – believing in God’s promise. They were ready to possess their land! When trouble arose, they abandoned what they understood.

Num 13:27-29

27And they told him, and said, We came unto the land whither thou sentest us, and surely it floweth with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it.

28Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: and moreover we saw the children of Anak there.

29The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: and the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.

KJV

Mark 4:17

17And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

Jesus warned us, to stick with what we understand to be true.

Mark 4:17

17But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away.

NIV

Another example is Peter.

Matt 14:25-31

25And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.

26And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.

27But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.

28And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.

29And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

30But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

31And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

KJV

Circumstances can not have Lordship in you life.

Mark 4:17

17And have no root in themselves,

KJV

Mark 4:16

16And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;
KJV

Mark 4:2-5

2And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his doctrine,
3Hearken; Behold, there went out a sower to sow:
4And it came to pass, as he sowed, some fell by the way side, and the fowls of the air came and devoured it up.
5And some fell on stony ground, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth:
KJV

Matt 13:5-6

5Some fell upon stony places, where they had not much earth: and forthwith they sprung up, because they had no deepness of earth:
6And when the sun was up, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away.
KJV

1 Thess 3:1-6

3:1Finally, when I could stand it no longer, I decided to stay alone in Athens 2and send Timothy, our brother and fellow worker, God's minister, to visit you to strengthen your faith and encourage you and to keep you from becoming fainthearted in all the troubles you were going through. (But of course you know that such troubles are a part of God's plan for us Christians.
4Even while we were still with you we warned you ahead of time that suffering would soon come-and it did.)
5As I was saying, when I could bear the suspense no longer, I sent Timothy to find out whether your faith was still strong. I was afraid that perhaps Satan had gotten the best of you and that all our work had been useless.
TLB

1 Cor 3:1-9

3:1Dear brothers, I have been talking to you as though you were still just babies in the Christian life who are not following the Lord but your own desires; I cannot talk to you as I would to healthy Christians who are filled with the Spirit. 2I have had to feed you with milk and not with solid food because you couldn't digest anything stronger. And even now you still have to be fed on milk. 3For you are still only baby Christians, controlled by your own desires, not God's. When you are jealous of one another and divide up into quarreling groups, doesn't that prove you are still babies, wanting your own way? In fact, you are acting like people who don't belong to the Lord at all. 4There you are, quarreling about whether I am greater than Apollos, and dividing the church. Doesn't this show how little you have grown in the Lord?
5Who am I, and who is Apollos, that we should be the cause of a quarrel? Why, we're just God's servants, each of us with certain special abilities, and with our help you believed. 6My work was to plant the seed in your hearts, and Apollos' work was to water it, but it was God, not we, who made the garden grow in your hearts. 7The person who does the planting or watering isn't very

important, but God is important because he is the one who makes things grow. 8Apollós and I are working as a team, with the same aim, though each of us will be rewarded for his own hard work. 9We are only God's coworkers. You are God's garden, not ours; you are God's building, not ours.
