

THE WORD IS ALIVE

The Word of God is alive!!

Heb 4:12

12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
(KJV)

Greek = The Word of God is a living thing

It is powerful - to pierce, to divide
the spirit, the soul, and the body (the joints and marrow)

This Word will produce power in your spirit
This Word will produce power in your soul (the mind, will, and emotions)
This Word will produce power in your body (the joints and the marrow)

The Word is powerful in all three areas.

Remember that spiritual words can create physical things.
He created all things by His words.

In John 6:63 Jesus said, "the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit and they are life."

Can words become flesh?

When God made Adam, he was just a shell.

There was no life in Adam until God breathed the breath of life into him.

Jesus wasn't made the same way as Adam.

Concerning Jesus the Bible says "The Word became flesh."

It's pretty powerful if The Word could produce a body for Jesus to indwell.

The Word is alive, sharp, powerful.

IKing 18:1

1 And it came to pass after many days, that the word of the LORD came to Elijah in the third year, saying, Go, shew thyself unto Ahab; and I will send rain upon the earth.
(KJV)

IKing 18:42-46

42 So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees,

43 And said to his servant, Go up now, look toward the sea. And he went up, and looked, and said, There is nothing. And he said, Go again seven times.

44 And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare thy chariot, and get thee down, that the rain stop thee not.

45 And it came to pass in the mean while, that the heaven was black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain. And Ahab rode, and went to Jezreel.

46 And the hand of the LORD was on Elijah; and he girded up his loins, and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.

(KJV)

The might of the Lord came on him. It was the hand of the Lord. This power can come upon us the same way. You can get so far out on the Word that His power will supercharge your whole body.

Mark 5:1-13

1 And they came to the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gerasenes.

2 And when He had come out of the boat, immediately a man from the tombs with an unclean spirit met Him,

3 and he had his dwelling among the tombs. And no one was able to bind him anymore, even with a chain;

4 because he had often been bound with shackles and chains, and the chains had been torn apart by him, and the shackles broken in pieces, and no one was strong enough to subdue him.

5 And constantly night and day, among the tombs and in the mountains, he was crying out and gashing himself with stones.

6 And seeing Jesus from a distance, he ran up and bowed down before Him;

7 and crying out with a loud voice, he said, "What do I have to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God, do not torment me!"

8 For He had been saying to him, "Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!"

9 And He was asking him, "What is your name?" And he said to Him, "My name is Legion; for we are many."

10 And he began to entreat Him earnestly not to send them out of the country.

11 Now there was a big herd of swine feeding there on the mountain.

12 And the demons entreated Him, saying, "Send us into the swine so that we may enter them."

13 And He gave them permission. And coming out, the unclean spirits entered the swine; and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea, about two thousand of them; and they were drowned in the sea.

(NAS)

This strength was not the normal human strength.

This man's physical human body was responding to spiritual power (even though it was demonic, evil power).

This spiritual power affected this man's physical body.

The Holy Spirit's power is greater than all the demons this side of heaven.

The Holy Spirit is with us now. He's here right now.

When we accept Jesus, the Bible tells us that we enter into a better covenant.

So, when I read about the Power of God coming upon men in the Old Testament and enabling them to destroy 800 men in one day, or even Elijah who killed 400 prophets of Baal, HOW MUCH MORE....

There is provision about superhuman men and women who will "know their God, be strong and do great exploits!"

Let's look at this man Elijah...

IKing 18:31-38

31 And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, unto whom the word of the LORD came, saying, Israel shall be thy name:

32 And with the stones he built an altar in the name of the LORD: and he made a trench about the altar, as great as would contain two measures of seed.

33 And he put the wood in order, and cut the bullock in pieces, and laid him on the wood, and said, Fill four barrels with water, and pour it on the burnt sacrifice, and on the wood.

34 And he said, Do it the second time. And they did it the second time. And he said, Do it the third time. And they did it the third time.

35 And the water ran round about the altar; and he filled the trench also with water.

36 And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, **and that I have done all these things at thy word.**

37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.

38 Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench.

(KJV)

His secret? "At thy Word.."

There were some other Word people in the Bible.

Luke 5:1-10

1 And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret,

2 And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing their nets.

3 And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.

4 Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.

5 And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: **nevertheless at thy word** I will let down the net.

6 And when they had this done, they inclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.

7 And they beckoned unto their partners, which were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. And they came, and filled both the ships, so that they began to sink.

8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord.

9 For he was astonished, and all that were with him, at the draught of the fishes which they had taken:

10 And so was also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.

(KJV)

Matt 8:5-8

5 And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,

6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

7 And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.

8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: **but speak the word only**, and my servant shall be healed.

(KJV)

The word is power of God to you and your circumstances.
Put enough word in you to make the circumstances change.

Mark 9:23-27

23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

John 4:1-14

1 When therefore the Lord knew how the Pharisees had heard that Jesus made and baptized more disciples than John,
2 (Though Jesus himself baptized not, but his disciples,)
3 He left Judaea, and departed again into Galilee.
4 And he must needs go through Samaria.
5 Then cometh he to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.
6 Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with his journey, sat thus on the well: and it was about the sixth hour.
7 There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink.
8 (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.)
9 Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.
10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.
11 The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water?
12 Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?
13 Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:
14 **But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.**
(KJV)

John 4:15-34

15 The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw.

16 Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.

17 The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband:

18 For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.

19 The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.

20 Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.

21 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.

22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

25 The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things.

26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he.

27 And upon this came his disciples, and marvelled that he talked with the woman: yet no man said, What seekest thou? or, Why talkest thou with her?

28 The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men,

29 Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?

30 Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.

31 In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat.

32 But he said unto them, I have meat to eat that ye know not of.

33 Therefore said the disciples one to another, Hath any man brought him ought to eat?

34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

(KJV)

Here is a man named Jesus, who was stronger in his spirit than in his flesh. Jesus was wall to wall power. Jesus nourished His body from His spirit within Him (He didn't do it with natural food and vitamins). Jesus showed us that there is a way to feed the body from inward life.

He just taught this woman that there is a flow of the force of life.

He said that out of our bellies shall flow the living waters...

If you will drink of Him the force will flow out....

So WE can live this life as SUPERCHARGED SUPERNATURAL MEN AND WOMEN OF GOD - DOING HIS WILL WHILE THERE IS STILL TIME!!!!

Prov 4:20-23

20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.
21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.
22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.
23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.
(KJV)

God has and can anoint men and women to operate in the manifestations or gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Miracles can and do happen through men's hands - they do through my hands.

Acts 19:11-12

11 And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:
12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.
(KJV)

The will of God is for us to put the alive, powerful, quick Word in us in such a degree that our bodies will walk in divine health.

There is a truth here....grasp it....it is shown to us throughout the Bible....

THIS IS THE PRINCIPAL BEHIND THE SCRIPTURE THAT SAYS...

Ps 107:20

20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.
(KJV)

Speak to the spirit man on the inside of you if you have symptoms and let the reservoir of the word in you spring up - let that force of life flow out of that heart you guard - let the word he sent heal you.

GO TO THE WELL AND DRINK!! SOME OF YOU NEED TO GO TO THE WELL.

This is the reason I recorded the tape and CD of healing scriptures, so people who are sick, on bed rest, people who can read or can't see can hear the word over and over.....

Rom 8:11-14

11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.
13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

...then he tells us how to do it....

14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
(KJV)

If your body tells you that you're sick, you don't have to believe it.
If your flesh is screaming about how tired you are, you don't have to obey it.

It says He'll quicken your mortal body.

To "quicken" in the Greek means to "make alive, give life, revitalize, raise up."

When you fill up the spirit man with the word of God, the inner man is built up. You can transfer that power to your physical body by standing on the word and acting on that word. Your confession and praying in tongues will also apply inward spiritual power to your flesh. If you will saturate yourself in the Word of God, eat it, breath it, listen to it in person and on tape, meditate on it, speak it, chew it, read it, **IT WILL EVENTUALLY BREAK OUT AND HEAL YOUR BODY AND RAISE YOU UP INTO DIVINE HEALTH.**
